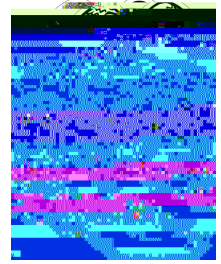

The Department of Public Safety would like to inform the St. Thomas community about four burglaries that have recently occurred on campus. All four incidents have specifically targeted the Lee and Perry Anderson construction site on the south campus. In each case, the suspects stole construction tools. No other buildings in the vicinity have been affected, but we believe it is important to share this information with our community.

On December 11, 2024, the construction site supervisor reported multiple burglaries to our department. We are now aware of four separate incidents that took place on the following dates: November 18, 2024; November 27, 2024; December 1, 2024; and December 9, 2024. No other burglaries have been reported within other buildings on south campus. We do not have any suspect information to share at this time.

In partnership with the construction company, Public Safety is implementing additional security measures to enhance the safety and protection of the construction site and its surrounding area.

As part of our ongoing commitment to community safety, we would like to remind everyone of the following crime prevention tips:

Stay aware of your surroundings at all times.

Always lock your doors and windows to your room or apartment.

Do not provide access to any secured building on campus.

Immediately report any suspicious activity or crimes to Public Safety or local law enforcement.

If you see something, say something.

We will continue to monitor the situation and encourage everyone to remain vigilant.
