This page includes information on first steps, what documents you should have ready for your application, what it means to apply WITH financial help, and more.

If you believe you qualify for a *public* program coverage, which includes Medical Assistance (MA) and MinnesotaCare (MNCare), you can submit your application (with financial assistance) at any time of the year.

If you know you are not eligible for public coverage and need to enroll in a *private* health insurance plan, submit your application during open enrollment. Open enrollment for 2022 coverage runs from November 1, 2021 through January 15, 2022.

There are some circumstances in which you can qualify for a Special Enrollment Period outside of open enrollment. You can find more information on those here:
